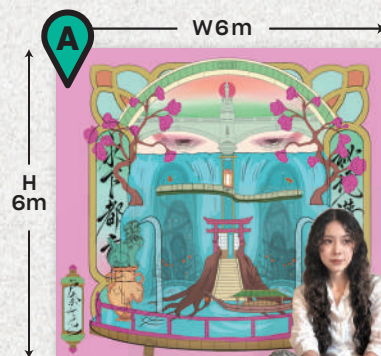

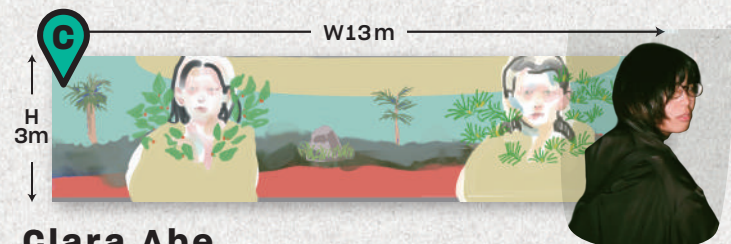

Theme "Connections of the City"

Nihonbashi has changed significantly over the years, but what has remained unchanged? The answer to that question was "the form of human". The work also depicts "forms of nature"—such as the plants and rocks seen throughout the Nihonbashi neighborhood—as elements that have endured unchanged.

About the Project

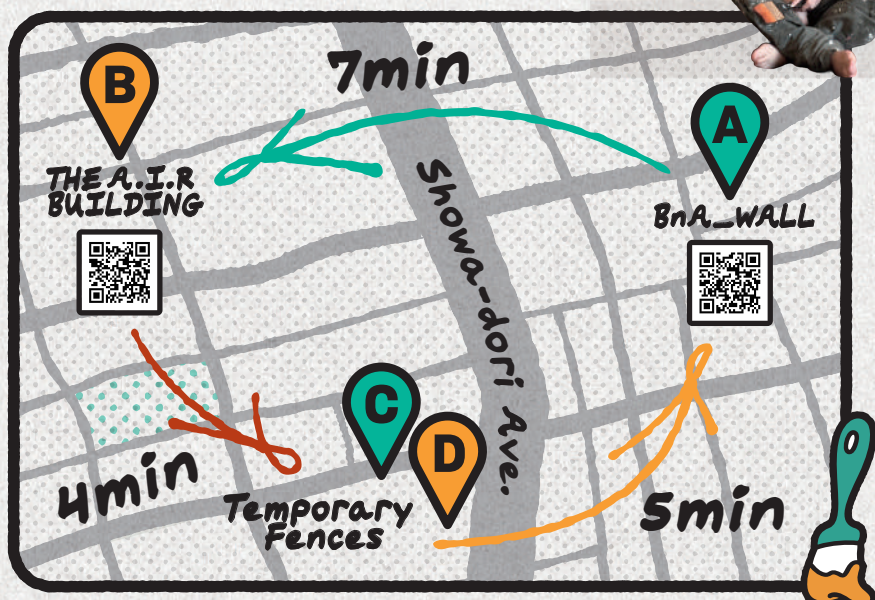
An art project launched by stationery and art supply manufacturer ASTRUM Corp., in collaboration with BnA Co., Ltd., which operates art hotels, and TokyoDex Inc., an art agency that connects artists with businesses. Based in Nihonbashi—the birthplace of Pentel—the project aims to foster mural artists who will go on to make their mark on the global stage. Now in its third year, four artists selected from over 290 applicants created murals on walls in Nihonbashi using Pentel art supplies. Through this project, guided by its vision of "Bringing Art into Everyday Life," Pentel aims to provide young artists with a platform for creativity while fostering mural art—which connects neighborhoods and people through art—as a new cultural phenomenon that takes root in the community.

Theme "Connections of the City"

Nihonbashi is made up of many distinct areas, each with its own history. I depicted motifs such as messenger runner, reeds, and people out for a stroll to express how the people who live (or once lived) in these areas move back and forth between the blocks that represent them. Since the artwork is a long, horizontal piece facing the street, I designed this way so that viewers can enjoy seeing how the scene unfolds as they walk by.



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
